### **Family and Student Access**

Please use your student's OSIS number to access the survey. Families will enter "f" followed by their child's nine-digit Student Identification (OSIS) Number to access the survey. Note that "f" must be lowercase.

Students in grades 6-12 will enter just their Student Identification (OSIS) Number to access the survey. A student's OSIS number can be found on their report card, student ID card, or in the family's NYCSA account.

As we plan for our school community in 2021-22 school year, we cannot predict what September will look like but with your help we can be prepared for a range of possibilities.

Please complete the survey at your earliest convenience and thank you in advance for your support.
